Monday	<p>Starter: Nursery rhymes/ Weekend News</p> <p>Main Activity: Discuss the story (The Rainbow Fish by Marcus Pfister)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why may he not want to give away his sparkly scales? • The Rainbow Fish gives away his most prized possessions. What are your most prized possessions? <p>The Rainbow Fish's scales are 'every shade of blue, green and purple'. Can you try mixing paint to make lots of different shades of these colours?</p> <p>Using watercolours to create their own rainbow fish.</p> <p>Child initiated learning/enabling environments will be accessible both inside and outside throughout the day</p>	The Rainbow Fish by Marcus Pfister
Tuesday	<p>Starter: Nursery rhymes</p> <p>Main Activity: Following on from yesterday, now we can decorate the fish using glitter, tin foil etc.</p> <p>Child initiated learning/enabling environments will be accessible both inside and outside throughout the day</p>	The Rainbow Fish by Marcus Pfister
Wednesday	<p>Starter: Nursery rhymes</p> <p>Main Activity: Play the song 'under the sea' for the children to create movement too.</p> <p>Go outside and encourage mark making to be explored by using different rollers and brushes, for the children to use the water to 'paint' on the floor, and even some big paper depending on the weather.
