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| Monday | <p>Starter: Read Funnybones nursery rhyme: head shoulders, knees and toes</p> <p>Main Activity: Circle time pass around a teddy. Each person to introduce themselves. Tell the group their favourite toy to play with and something they did in the six weeks holidays.</p> <p>Child initiated learning/enabling environments will be accessible both inside and outside throughout the day</p> | <p>Funnybones by Janer & Allan Ahlberg Teddy - circle time</p> |
| Tuesday | <p>Starter: Read Funnybones Song: Shake dem Halloween bones</p> <p>Children to discuss the body parts they could see in the video. Involve the children in the nursery rhyme Body Parts</p> <p>Main Activity: Children to make hand prints using paint. | Wednesday | <p>Starter: Number songs (The singing walrus 1-10) Nursery Rhyme: 10 green bottles</p> <p>Main Activity: Play a game of finding numbers outside, see which numbers children recognise. Firstly hide 0-5 then play again with numbers 5-10. Watch "Keep your hands to yourself" Discuss sharing - is it nice if we just take something? How does it make others feel?
