## Welcome Back

Welcome to a new term and a new school year at Hamsterley Primary School – even if it is a very strange one! We are delighted to welcome all of our new pupils and new parents.

The staff and children have all made a fantastic start to the year and are taking the current situation in their stride. We were unbelievably proud of all of our children and how well they coped with the first day of school after so long away. We have been busy in the last week or so gathering information from the children as to where they are with their learning, so that we can put a plan in place to best support and accelerate their learning. We will also be ensuring that we support their well-being on a day to day basis as they continue to adjust.

This year, we are hoping to provide you with a weekly newsletter, enabling us to update you on a regular basis as to what is happening in school.

## Remote Learning

We are currently looking at our remote learning offer to try to improve it for all our children and parents, ensuring that children not attending school due to Covid-19, either through self-isolation or lockdowns, are able to access similar learning to that taking place in the classroom. Our children not missing teaching and learning at the moment is essential if we are going to enable them to catch up quickly. We will provide more details in the next week or so.

## Drop off reminder

We would like to remind parents that maintaining 'bubbles' and social distancing is essential at the moment. Therefore we would be grateful if children arrived promptly at school, not more than 5 minutes before their start time and not more than 10 minutes after. We must all work together to try to keep everyone safe. We would also like to remind you that at present no parents are allowed on site. Children in Class 2 should arrive at 8:45, and those in Class 1 (or in Class 2 with siblings in Class 1) should arrive at 9:00.

## Drinks Bottles

Please ensure that your child has their own cleaned water bottle in school each day.

Parent Pay accounts are updated at the end of each week, please ensure you log into your account each Friday to make any payment due for that week.

## Wrap around care

Please ensure you pre-book your child into wrap around care for the following week by 2.30pm on Fridays. Alternatively, you can pre-book wrap around care for the term.

If parents do not wish to apply online they can complete a paper application form, and these are available to print from the website (same website address as above) from Monday the 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020.
